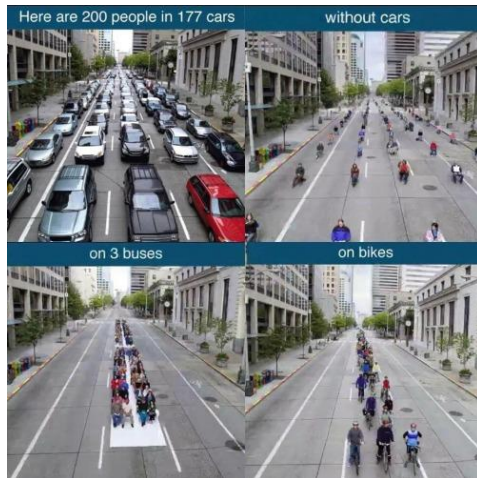

[Middle East drones signal end to era of fast jet air supremacy](#). Undetected drones erased half of Saudi Arabia oil production. Israel now uses regularly drones instead of its Air Force planes. This is a paradigm shift that goes beyond defense. Mobility solutions that are much smaller, less expensive and with less environmental impacts are available also for water and land mobility: unmanned aquatic drones may replace submarines; and micro and mini mobility solutions are making cars obsolete, at least in city centers.
