“... ARM is the only remaining UK technology company, with a dominant position in mobile phone microprocessors. ...As the American president has weaponized technology dominance in his trade war with China, the UK will become collateral damage unless it has its own trade weapons to bargain with. ...A sale to Nvidia will mean that ARM becomes subject to the US OFAC regulations. This puts Britain in the invidious position that the decision about who ARM can sell to will be made in the White House and not in Downing Street.”
