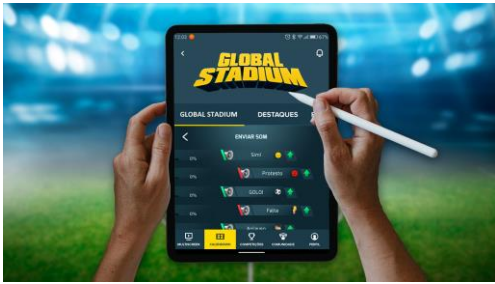

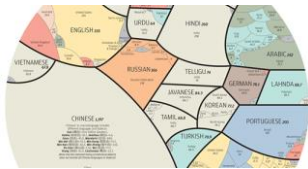
[Global Stadium](#) was launched by [SportTv](#). This is a true innovation in televised (sports) events: real fans, real noises in real time.

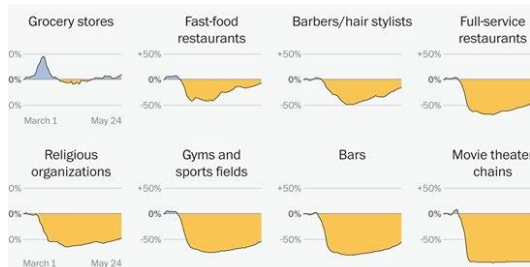

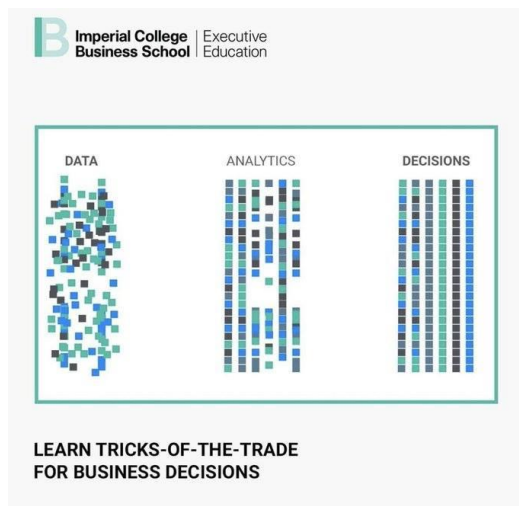
